

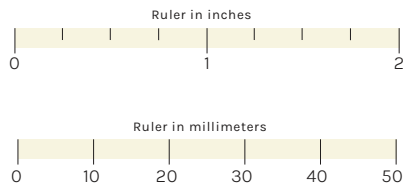

### How to determine your ring size?

Let's do it together step by step...

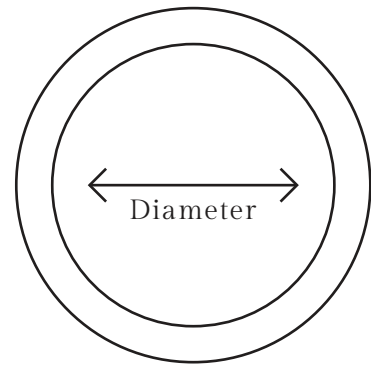
#### CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE



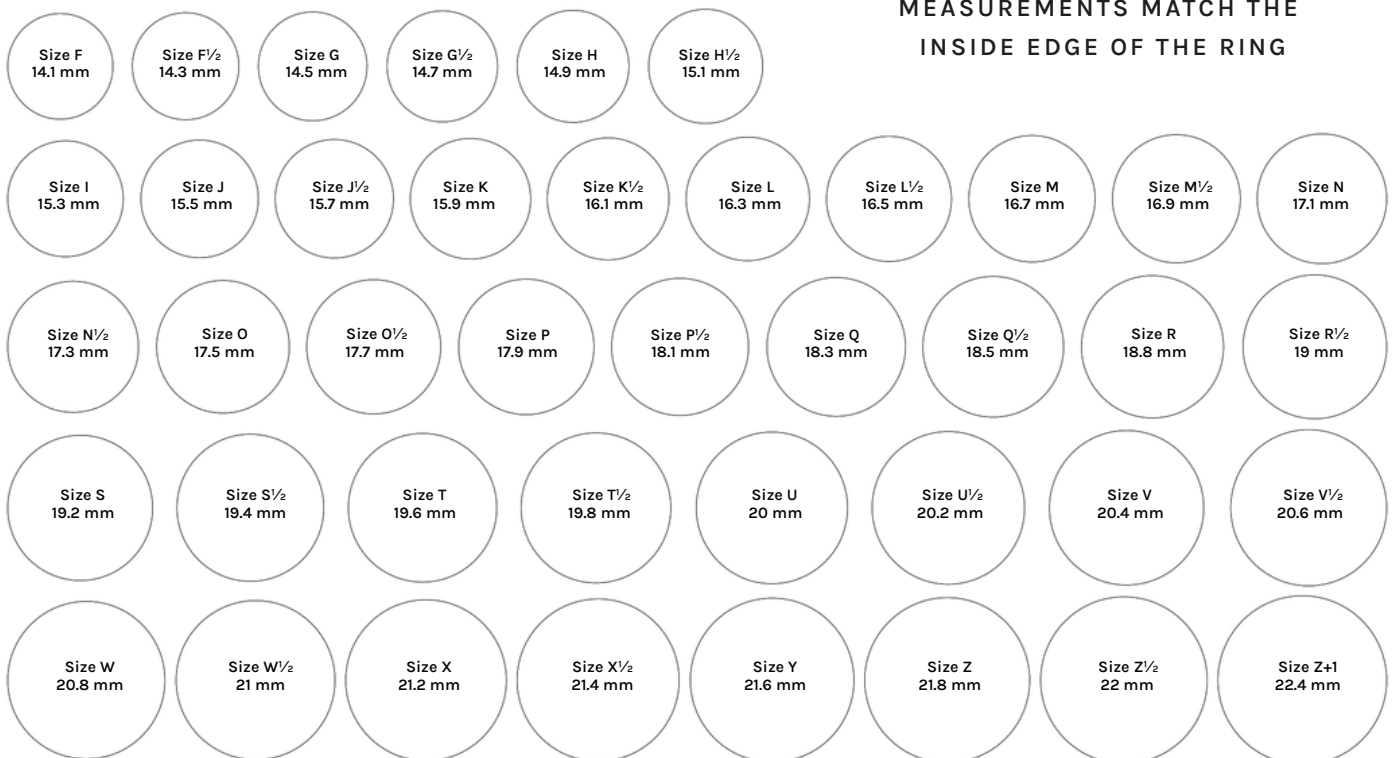
1. Ring measurements are very precise. Carefully follow these instructions to obtain an accurate measurement.
2. Prior to printing, ensure that Page Scaling is set to "Actual Size" on your print dialog box.
3. Measure the bar on the left. It must be exactly 2 inches or 50 mm long.

#### MEASURE CURRENT RING

1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
2. Place the ring over the circles below. Match the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. This measurement refers to the diameter of the ring.
3. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.



#### MEASUREMENTS MATCH THE INSIDE EDGE OF THE RING



Measurements reflect ring sizes in South Africa, England, Ireland and Australia.

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### MEASURING YOUR FINGER

The ring should fit your finger comfortably; snug enough so that it will not fall off, but loose enough to slide over your knuckles.

Generally, finger sizes change depending on the time of day, your level of hydration, and the weather. For best results measure your finger size:

1. At the end of the day and when your fingers are warm, fingers are smaller in the early morning especially when it is cold.
2. Measure your finger size three to four times to eliminate an erroneous measurement.

Avoid using string or paper to measure ring size as these materials can stretch or twist, yielding an inaccurate measurement.

### INTERNATIONAL SIZE CONVERSION

If ordering from outside South Africa, determine your ring size according to your country's standard. Then use the International Ring Size Chart to convert to the corresponding South African ring size to place your order.

### USING A RING THAT FITS

1. Select a ring that fits the intended finger well.
2. Measure the inner diameter of this ring in millimeters.
3. Find the corresponding ring size on an online chart.

### TIPS FOR BUYING THE RING AS A SURPRISE

- **Ask Friends or Family:** Subtly ask your significant other's friends or close family members if they know their ring size. Make sure they understand the need for discretion to keep the surprise intact.
- **Borrow a Ring:** Borrow a ring that your significant other wears on the same finger you plan to place the new ring – bring it to one of our design studios to determine the size.
- **Measure the Ring:** If you can't borrow the ring, place the ring on our printable ring size guide to determine the size.
- **Ask Casually:** Bring up the topic of jewellery in casual conversation. Mention a story or a friend's engagement to steer the conversation towards ring sizes and preferences naturally.
